



## Instructions for completing an application to be a delegate.

All applications must be submitted no later than 6:00 pm on Friday, May 22, 2026.

Applicants must complete both the IDGOP Delegate Pledge form and the Ad County Republican Central Committee 2026 Republican State Convention Delegate Application.

The State form is used statewide and although it does say “This form must be brought with you to your delegate selection meeting at the County or Legislative District level” submitting it as a part of your application fulfills this requirement. However, if you also seek to be nominated at your Legislative District organization meeting, a separate form must be taken there.

When completing the County Application, reenter contact information from the state form.

**PC Status** If you are a PC running for reelection in an uncontested race, check priority 1. If you are running in a contested race and apply prior to the results being known, enter a “C” to alert the committee to the fact your status is pending.

**Time.** For each question in the time category, enter the point value if you are claiming points for any subcategory. Be sure to describe your self-directed service in the space provided.

**Talent.** The talent portion is a narrow category. The first question refers to specific services provided that were donated in lieu of a service that would otherwise have been paid for.

Services must be documented as an in-kind contribution. Verification shall consist of a receipt, invoice, or written acknowledgment issued by the ACRCC reflecting the donated service and its fair market value. Services lacking ACRCC-issued documentation do not qualify.

Service as a partisan elected county officer is limited only to those elected Ada County office holders serving as a Commissioner, the Assessor, Clerk, Coroner, Prosecutor, Sherrif, or Treasurer. Non-partisan local municipal officers were not included in this list.

**Treasure.** Points are awarded for cash-only contributions to the ACRCC. In-kind contributions, including items donated for auction at the Lincoln Day Dinner are excluded from this category. Enter the dollar amount donated and claim the points for ACRCC Contributions.

For contributions to the Idaho Republican Party or Republican candidates in partisan races in the general election, contributions must be reported in the state party reports (either FEC or Sunshine) or candidate Sunshine reports.

### Submitting the Form

Once completed, either insert a signature image or type your name as follows: **(Signed): First name, Last Name** Save the application and submit it by email. Emails must be received prior to 6:00 pm on Friday, May 22, 2026.
